

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

PLASU Journal of Archival, Library and Information Science (PLASUJALIS) is bi-annual publication of the Department of Library and Information Science, Plateau State University, Bokoos. The journal is devoted to the dissemination of research findings and general knowledge in Health Information, Business Information, Archival Management, Records Management, Library and Information Science and affiliated fields.

The Editorial Board therefore advises interested contributors to submit articles for publication as follows:

1. All articles submit to the PLASU Journal of Archival, Library and Information Science (PLASUJALIS) must be original. If any of the material has been published or submitted elsewhere, this must be made clear to the Chief Editor in written and should be resolved. All submissions should be made through the online submission system.
2. Articles for publication should be written in English Language and must not be more than fifteen (15) pages, including abstracts and references.
3. Abstracts should have a minimum of three keywords and should not be more than two hundred and fifty (250) words.
4. Articles should be submitted in MS-Word 2007 or later version. No other Word Processing Application are accepted.
5. The article should be typed in double line spacing and on one side of A4 paper.
6. The fonts should be in Times New Roman size 12.
7. The article should bear the name of the author(s), address of the institution/organization, phone number and email.

Second page: Main content text with all tables and figures aligned in their location. The contents should follow the following format:

1. Introduction: should cover the background of the study, rationale and objectives.
2. Literature Review (Optional): should be sufficient, well-argued and backed with current citations/references.
3. Methodology: should clearly describe research methods and statistical techniques used.
4. Results: should be described with appropriate statistical techniques, tables and figures if needed.
5. Discussion
6. Conclusions
7. Appendixes (optional)
8. References for both print and electronic sources must be compliant with the APA style (7th edition).
9. Contributing authors are bound by the decision of the Editorial Board on the status of each article. However, the Editorial Board shall not be held liable for opinions, expressions and facts found in any manuscripts but would take the copyright ownership of such publication.
10. Preference would be given to empirical, well-researched papers.
11. Be notified that the PLASUJALIS will be available online.

12. All articles for publications should be submitted online through the journal email: plasujalis@gmail.com and each article should be accompanied with the sum of five thousand naira (₦5,000.00) assessment fee.
13. All accepted articles for publication should be submitted along with a publication fee of twenty thousand naira (₦20,000.00).
